## Role of Resident Associations in building and construction industry

- Feedback channel on construction standards, development control and expectations of end users
- Participation in policy/legislative formulation processes - represent interest of their members
- Monitoring compliance to regulations and set standards in the construction industry; zoning regulations;



## Role of Resident Associations in building and construction industry

- Facilitating structured engagement between residents, government & other industry players
- Protection of members interests securing open spaces, environmental protection; value for money
- Channel for educating & informing end users on their roles and responsibilities as well as expected service provision standards

## Results of Resident Association Role in Building and construction industry

- Structured engagement with the various actors in the industry has led to harmonious relationship in a number of cases
- Participation in policy and legislative processes has led to instruments that reflect views & expectations of the end users
- Upholding of zoning regulations & other laws that govern construction industry



## Results of Resident Association Role in Building and construction industry

- Increased awareness of the end user on their roles & responsibilities in promoting sustainable development
- Value for money residents protected from unscrupulous developers – quality of development
- Protection of open spaces or road reserves from interference

## Action

- Formulate policies and legislations that facilitate effective participation of Resident Associations in planning & development processes e.g. Nairobi & Kiambu. Associations representatives should be in the approval committees & should be adequately consulted
- Improve access to information: Build an econsultation hub/portal to promote access to information & effective consultation



## Action

- Joint (government, private sector & resident associations) public awareness campaign on construction industry standards, regulations & opportunities for public involvement – Residents Dialogue Forums; Roundtable discussions for industry players with resident associations
- Encourage and facilitate development of Local Physical Development Plans for various zones & have the plans adopted & used to guide development
- Commission a citizens report card survey on state of construction industry – opportunity to get feedback on expectations & challenges
